ABOUT BUILDING 3

Building 3 is a repurposed 1970s warehouse, home to many local favourites including Canteen, Capital Brewing Co, Grainger Gallery and Keep Co along with naturopathy services, a guitar studio, theatre, hair salon, chocolate producer, yoga studios, distillers and a kids play centre. The redesign has created a village within a building. Intimate internal laneways extend inwards, meeting at three central public squares. The laneways and courtyards provide places for workers and visitors to linger, encouraging interaction and neighbourly sharing. Building 3 received the Commendation for Urban Design at the National Architecture Awards 2023.

ABOUT DAIRY ROAD

Dairy Road is a 14-hectare site in Canberra's East Lake. It sits between the industrial suburb of Fyshwick and the human-made nature reserve, the Jerrabomberra Wetlands. Existing warehouses on the site have been repurposed for a new community of tenants. Gardens and public spaces have replaced asphalt and concrete. Dairy Road is already home to a community of 40 commercial tenants with annual visitation of 800,000 people. The long term vision is for an interconnected neighbourhood where often-separated parts work together as an ecosystem. In time, working, living, recreation, retail, entertainment and light industry will take place in a restored native landscape.
